AWARUA NETWORK PROJECT Notice of Power Outage

Dear customer,

We're getting in touch to let you know that there will be a planned power outage affecting your property on:

Monday, 21 July 2025, from 9:30am to 2:30pm.

This outage is necessary so our team can safely carry out work that can't be completed while the network is live or operating under generation. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding.

This work is part of the Awarua Network Project and involves removal of existing network equipment to make way for the new line build, as well as installation of an underground cable near the back of the Invercargill Racecourse off Findlay Road.

Please remember to treat all power lines as live at all times, as power may be restored earlier than the scheduled time once the work is complete.

Property access

While this work is completed there will be traffic management in place on Findlay Road and Bethunes Lane. Residents in this area will continue to have access to their properties, although there may be a short period (of approximately 10 minutes) that access is unavailable.
